We start this month with Trinity Sunday. The Trinity can be confusing – three persons in one God. St Patrick used the example of the shamrock leaf. Another way of demonstrating Trinity is the three forms of water – ice, water and steam. The Trinity reminds us that we meet God in different ways; he is ready to meet us in the best way for us.

The Trinity is a perfect community or fellowship in which the members work together in total unity; God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit are always of one mind and intent. The community of the Trinity is one which we are invited to join as we come to know God better.

Trinity Sunday also marks the beginning of 'Ordinary Time' in the church year. This provides us with the opportunity to learn more about Jesus away from the big seasons of Christmas, Lent and Easter. We can listen to the teachings of Jesus, see his miracles and

see how he communicated with very diverse people, calling them into community.

Ordinary Time coincides with summer and so the part of the year when people take a break from normal routine. May we take this opportunity to come together in community, working with one another and supporting each other.
