It is not too late to join in the Lent Group on Friday lunch times where we are looking at '5 Women in the Bible'.

March ends with the most significant week of the Christian year. After the six weeks of discipline, Sunday 24th is Palm Sunday as we remember our Lord's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the promised Messiah has arrived. Then we walk with Jesus during those last days leading to the celebration of the Last Supper on Maundy Thursday followed by Christ's suffering on Good Friday. Easter Saturday is almost a 'none day', nothing happens, it is a time of waiting. We know what is to come next and so use that day to prepare and decorate the Church ready for the big celebration of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Day.

It is all too easy to jump from the excitement of Palm Sunday to the celebration of Easter Day – Sunday to Sunday. If we do that then we miss what it is really all about. We cannot have Easter Day without Good Friday. Christ suffered and died before he rose again. We need to have the difficult time in order to fully celebrate the joy of the amazing good which God has given us through Jesus.
