As the season of Easter draws to an end, May gives us a wealth of special days – Rogation Sunday, Ascension Day, Pentecost Sunday (also known as Whit Sunday) and Trinity Sunday. Whilst Trinity Sunday may have the distinction of being the difficult one to explain, Rogation Sunday is, perhaps, the least well known. Rogation Sunday is always on the sixth Sunday of Easter, just five weeks after Easter Day. It has this name because the following three days, which are the three days before Ascension Day, are Rogation Days. They are days when we ask God's blessing for our community and its sustenance. They are days for praying for agriculture and industry. From medieval times there has been a

tradition of 'beating the bounds', a procession around the borders of a community praying for God's blessing on the crops and so for the well-being of the community which depends on those crops. In more recent times praying for the community.

Perhaps as we walk or ride around our villages both on Rogation Sunday, and on those three Rogation Days, we can take some time to ask God's blessing on our communities. Thinking especially of those who live and work in them, and asking God's blessing on their work.

- For the Holy Spirit to renew our commitment to Christ
- For the Annual Parish meetings and those offering their time and expertise to share in the administration of the church
- For Peace throughout the world, especially in Israel-Palestine, Ukraine and all the troubled areas of the world.
- For our communities, for all who live and work in them that there work may prosper to the good of those doing the work and the community.
- For all who are suffering through illness or anxiety.
